Hebrew Alphabet Studies:

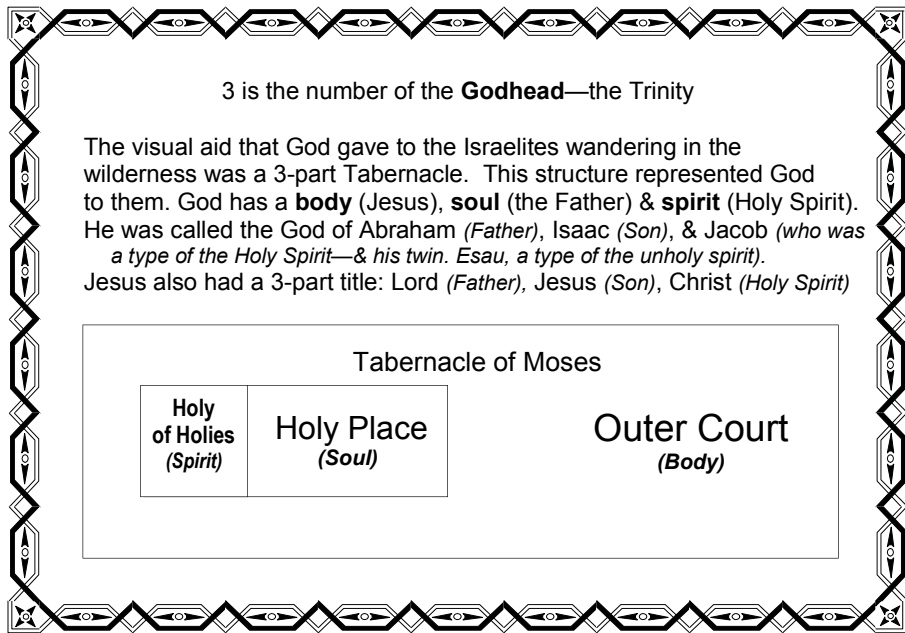
"gimel" "gamal" or "gamuwl" meaning "burden-bearer," "camel" or "reward" (Strong's Exhaustive Concordance #1576-1581)

 "G" (in English)

The English word for "redemption" in Hebrew is גאל pronounced "ga-al."

Hebrew is read from right to left. (It's interesting that gimels (camels) have 3 stomachs.)

"gimel" also is the Hebrew number 3

*The Trinity seen throughout creation

"For the **invisible things** of Him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power & Godhead, so that they are without excuse." (Romans 1:20)

Time is a trinity past, present, future

Matter is a trinity: liquid, solid, gas

Energy is a trinity: active/inactive/changing

Light is a trinity: red heat rays, yellow visible rays, ultraviolet invisible rays.

The Trinity in the Old Testament

"Come ye near unto me, hear ye thee: I have not spoken in secret from the beginning, from the time that it was, there AM I; & now the **LORD GOD, & HIS SPIRIT, hath sent ME.**" (Isaiah 48:16)

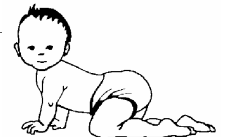
The Trinity seen in YOU

"And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly, and I pray God your whole **spirit** and **soul** and **body** be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ." (1 Thessalonians 5:23)

Keeping the 3 Feast-Times of Israel from our very inception

- 1st month, 14th day **Ovulation** (egg is created) on the 14th day of a woman's cycle.
- 1st month, 15th day **Fertilization** must occur within 24 hours.
- 1st month, 15-21 days **Implantation** of egg takes 2 to 7 days to travel down the fallopian tube.
- 3rd month **Heart** is developed at 7 weeks. The baby has all its internal organs.
- 7th month, 1st day **Ears** of the baby can now hear from the womb.
- 7th month, 10th day **Blood** of the baby is changed so that it can carry oxygen.
- 7th month, 15-23 days **Lungs** are developed to receive oxygen—the baby can survive if born.

9th month, 25th day Birth occurs about 280 days after conception. (Feast of **Dedication**, not in the Law of Moses, but Jesus kept it) (the above information is from Zola Levitt Ministries, Dallas, TX 75225)



The 3 Feast-Times of Israel not only depict the Godhead, but also His plan of Redemption for Mankind:
 "THREE times in the year shall all thy males appear before the Lord thy God...and they shall not appear before the Lord empty." (*Deuteronomy 16:16, also Exodus 23:17, 34:23*)

Feast of Pentecost (or Harvest)

Spirit Redemption
 (redeemed spirit-Ezekiel 36:27)

Feast of WEEKS (7x7 days) (Shavuot)
 50 days after Firstfruits* - Lev. 23:15-21, Dt. 16:9-12
 Fulfilled at Pentecost! - Acts 2

Feast of Tabernacles (or Ingathering)

Body Redemption
 (redeemed body-Isaiah 26:19)

Feast of Passover (or Unleavened Bread)

Soul Redemption
 (redeemed mind-Jeremiah 31:33-34)

March/April

FIRSTFRUITS (Yom HaBikkurim)
 1st month-day* after 1st Sabbath after Passover
 Leviticus 23:20: "And the priest shall wave them with the bread of the firstfruits for a wave offering before the Lord..." (*see also 1st Corinthians 15:20*)
 Fulfilled on Resurrection Day!

UNLEAVENED BREAD (Hag Hamatzah)-
 1st month-14th*-21st* day - Exodus 12:15:
 "7 days shall ye eat unleavened bread; even the first day ye shall put away leaven out of your houses..."
 (*see also Exodus 34:18, Leviticus 23:6-8, Deuteronomy 16:3-4,8 and 1 Corinthians 5:7-8*)
 Fulfilled by Jesus's life!

PASSOVER (Pesach)
 1st** month-14th day* - Exodus 12:13:
 "And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are; and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you..."
 (*see also Exodus 23, Leviticus 23, Deuteronomy 16, 1 Corinthians 5:8 and 1 Peter 1:18-19*)
 Fulfilled at the Cross of Christ!

(May/June)

TRUMPETS (Rosh Hoshanah "head trumpet")
 7th month-1st* day - Lev. 23:24:
 "...shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets" (*see also 1 Thess. 4:16, 1 Cor. 15:53b*)
 Unfulfilled

Sept/Oct

DAY OF ATONEMENT (Yom Kippur)
 7th month-10th* day - Lev. 23:29:
 "For whatsoever soul it be that shall not be afflicted in that same day he shall be cut off from among his people."
 (*see also 2 Corinthians 5:10, Revelation 20:12-13*)
 Unfulfilled

TABERNACLES (Succoth)
 7th month-15th*-22nd* day - Lev. 23:42:
 "Ye shall dwell in booths (tents) 7 days; all that are Israelites born shall dwell in booths."
 (*see also Deut. 16:13-15 & Zechariah 14:16*)
 Unfulfilled

(12th month (Feb/Mar)-14th-16th)
(Purim or Lots) Fast of Esther

Numbers 29 details the feast offerings.
 Solomon kept the feasts (2 Chron. 8:13).
 Ezra also kept the feasts (Ezra 3:4-5).

God's 3 mandatory annual VACATIONS (2 out of every 3 years):
 "And thou shalt eat before the Lord thy God, in the place which he shall choose to place his name there, **the tithes**...that thou mayest learn to fear the Lord thy God always.
 And if the way be too long for thee...or if the place be too far from thee...then shalt thou turn it into money and bind up the money in thine hand and shalt go unto the place which the Lord thy God shall choose: and thou shalt bestow that money for whatsoever thy soul lusteth after, for oxen, or for sheep, or for wine or for strong drink or for whatsoever thy soul desireth: and thou shalt eat there before the Lord thy God and thou shalt rejoice, thou, and thine household.
 At the end of 3 years thou shalt bring forth all the tithes of thine increase the same year, and shalt lay it up within thy gates and the Levite...and the stranger and the fatherless and the widow, which are within thy gates, shall come and shall eat and be satisfied: that the Lord thy God may bless thee in all the work of thine hand which thou doest." (Deuteronomy 14:23-29)

(9th month (Nov/Dec)-25th day)
Feast of Dedication (Hanukah)
 Jesus kept it (John 10:22-24).
 Not in the Law

*indicates Holy Sabbath Days - see back page.
 **1st month = 1st new moon in spring (Exodus 12:2).
