"yod" or "yad" meaning: "hand"
(Strong's Exhaustive Concordance #3027-3028)



"Y" (or 'J' in English)

Jehovah or Yahweh יהוה י

Jesus or Yeshua ישוע י

Jerusalem or Yerushalem ירושלים

"yod" also is the Hebrew number 10
(the hands together have 10 digits)

Psalm 119 is an alphabetic acrostic (in Hebrew)
divided into 22 sections
(1 for each letter of the Hebrew alphabet).

Each of these 22 sections has 8 verses that
start with the corresponding Hebrew letter.

Psalm 119:73-80 is the portion under the letter "Yod."
It begins with "...Thy **hands** have made me and fashioned me..."
(Psalm 119:73)

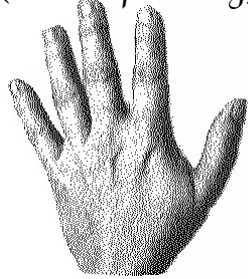

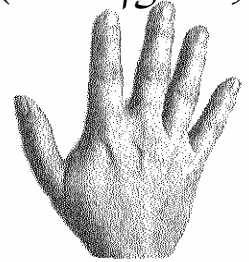

(Hand of Justice)



*Israel: those born into God's family who had applied the blood of the lamb to their dwelling.

10 Commandments (Exodus 20 & Deuteronomy 5)

- 1) I am the Lord thy God which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt out of the house of bondage. Thou shalt have no other gods before me.
- 2) Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image or any likeness of that in heaven above or in the earth beneath or in the water under the earth. Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them nor serve them, for I, the Lord thy God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers' upon the children unto the 3rd & 4th generation of them that hate me and showing mercy unto thousands of them that love me and keep my commandments.
- 3) Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.
- 4) **Exodus 20:9-11 version:**
 Remember the sabbath day to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labor and do all thy work but the 7th day is the sabbath of the Lord thy God; thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy man-servant, nor thy maid-servant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates. **For in 6 days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea and all that in them is & rested the 7th day, wherefore the Lord blessed the sabbath day and hallowed it.**
- 4) **Deuteronomy 5:13-15 version:**
 Six days thou shalt labor and do all thy work, but the 7th day is the sabbath of the Lord thy God; in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, nor thy man-servant, nor thy maid-servant, **nor thine ox, nor thine ass, nor any of thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates, that thy manservants and thy maidservants may rest as well as thou. And remember that thou wast a servant in the land of Egypt and the Lord thy God brought thee out thence through a mighty hand and by a stretched out arm: therefore, the Lord thy God commanded thee to keep the sabbath day.**
- 5) Honor thy father and thy mother that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.
- 6) Thou shalt not kill.
- 7) Thou shalt not commit adultery.
- 8) Thou shalt not steal.
- 9) Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.
- 10) Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's house thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbor's.
