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Blessing of the Priest

Grace & Peace

Those born into God's priesthood (Exodus 19:6, 1 Peter 2:5, Isaiah 61:6, John 20:22-23) are instructed to 'PUT' (translated 'MARK' in Genesis 4:15) God's Name* on His people (Numbers 6:22-27)



“And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, Speak unto Aaron and unto his sons, saying, ‘On this wise ye shall bless the children of Israel, saying unto them, The LORD bless thee, and keep thee: The LORD make his face shine upon thee, and be GRACIOUS unto thee: The LORD lift up his countenance upon thee, and give thee PEACE. And they shall PUT MY NAME upon the children of Israel; and I will bless them.”

* "... his Name is called The Word of God." Revelation 19:13

Speaking God's **Word aloud** marks people with His Name. So, be marked (& washed) DAILY. Never underestimate the power of the spoken Word. It's the source of all that is created. (Heb. 11:3)

The Hebrew letter shin (s or sh) represents the Name of God because it is the first letter of the word Shem (meaning 'Name'). It is also the first letter of the words: Shalom (peace), Shaddai (God) & Shekinah (glory).



The letter shin was made by those born into the priesthood using one (or both) hands forming the letter shin with their fingers while speaking the Aaronic Blessing (Numbers 6:22-26) of GRACE & PEACE.

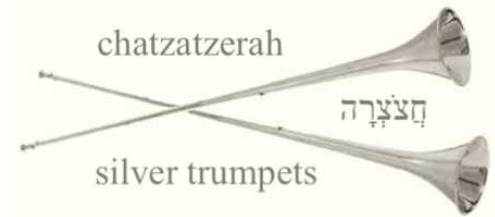


Note: Jewish actor Leonard Nimoy chose to adopt this as his 'Vulcan salute' with the verbal blessing 'live long and prosper' in the TV series Star Trek—but, for millenia, Jewish rabbi's have raised their hands with this same sign when they rose to impart God's Name upon His people, blessing them.

The Hebrew alphabet of 22 letters is found written in most Bibles in Psalm 119, marking 22 divisions of 8 verses—each starting with that letter (alphabetic acrostic). (Shin is the second to last letter of the Hebrew alphabet.)

*These New Testament epistles (letters) to churches were written by the Jewish rabbi, Saul—his Jewish name is mentioned 22 times before he changes it to a Gentile (non-Jewish) name (Paul) after Acts 7—when he becomes an apostle to the Gentiles. Indeed, Paul's life is an allegory of the Church—birthed into Judaism—and then becoming 'all things to all men...' (1 Corinthians 9:22)

HEBREWS 13:25 ends with "Grace be with you all. Amen." The apostle John finishes the Bible with:

Here are a few instances of Grace & Peace appearing together in scripture at MAJOR historical events in the Bible:
 Genesis 43:23&29: "And he (Joseph) said 'PEACE be to you...and he said: God be GRACIOUS unto thee...'
 Judges 6:17&23 "...if I (Gideon) have found GRACE...and the Lord said 'PEACE...'
 1 Samuel 1:17&18 "Then Eli answered (Hannah) and said 'Go in PEACE...and she said 'Let thine handmaid find GRACE...'
 1 Samuel 20:3&7, 21&29 "I (David) have found GRACE...thy servant shall have PEACE..."
 2 Samuel 15:25&27 "If I (David) shall find FAVOR (GRACE)...return to the city in PEACE..."
 Esther 2:11&15 "to know how Esther did (SHALOMED—literally: PEACED)...and Esther obtained FAVOR (GRACE)..."
 Luke 1:29&36 "...Jestest thou thy servant (Simeon) depart in PEACE...and there was one Anna (Ckhanna actually means GRACE)..."



For further study, within the Holy of Holies (where only the High Priest went), there were 2 Cherubim over the Ark of the Covenant. In the Holy Place (where Priests went) in Zechariah 4:3-14 were 2 Olive Trees In the Outer Court of Solomon's Temple (for all) were 2 Pillars (Jachin & Boaz 1 Kings 7:21 & 2 Chron. 3:17) representing the COVENANT OF GRACE—the salvation promised to Noah (Gen. 6:8) sealed with a rainbow—manifesting the 7-fold Spirit of Grace (Isaiah 11:2-3, Revelation 4:5, 5:6)—the eyes of the Lord' (Zech. 4:10, 2 Chron. 16:9) and the COVENANT OF PEACE—the inheritance promised to Abraham (renewed by each generation), sealed with flesh circumcision—manifested by death, burial & resurrection of the Prince of Peace (Numbers 25:12, Ephesians 2:14-17, Isaiah 9:6, John 14:27).
